



Stolen and Fleeing Vehicle Mobile Tracking Device Warrant Report

Minnesota Statutes § 626A.35

Minn. Stat. § 626A.35 permits law enforcement to utilize mobile tracking devices on stolen and fleeing motor vehicles under certain circumstances for a period of 12 hours. At the conclusion of the 12 hours, the law enforcement agency that attached the tracking device to the vehicle must either remove the device, disable the device, or obtain a search warrant granting approval to continue using the device in the investigation.

By August 1st of each year, chief law enforcement officers of agencies that have obtained warrants granting approval to continue using mobile tracking devices beyond the initial 12-hour period are required to provide notice to the Superintendent of the Minnesota Bureau of Criminal Apprehension (BCA) of the number of search warrants the agency obtained in the preceding 12 months. To that end, the BCA has created this form to assist agencies in meeting this statutory requirement.
