The information on this authorization form is classified by the federal Driver's Privacy Protection Act (the DPPA, 18 U.S.C. section 2721), the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act (the MGDPA, Minn. Stat. chapter 13) and Minnesota Statutes section 171.12. The information may be released in accordance with these laws. DVS may also release the information in response to a subpoena, court order, or inquiry by a state or legislative auditor.

Certification

The DPPA is enforced by the U.S. Department of Justice, which may seek civil and criminal penalties for improperly obtaining, disclosing, or using personal information from a driver's license or motor vehicle record for a purpose not permitted by law. In addition, private citizens may seek civil damages for improperly obtaining, disclosing or using the record.

The MGDPA limits access to and dissemination of government data, including information on a driver's license or motor vehicle record. Civil and criminal penalties may be imposed for violation of the law.

I certify the information and statements on this request are true and correct and comply with the provisions of the DPPA. I understand that the willful, unauthorized disclosure of information obtained from the record(s) for a purpose other than stated on this request, or the sale or other distribution of the information to a person or organization not disclosed in this request, may result in penalties imposed under federal and state law.
