## **About Minnesota VINE**

- Individuals can use Minnesota VINE to find out if a person is currently in a county jail or detention facility.
- Individuals can request to receive notifications by automated phone call, email, and/or text message.
- Individuals who request to be notified by phone will be asked to provide a phone number and PIN. When the custody status changes, notification attempts will continue for 24 hours until the PIN is entered.
- Notifications are prompted by changes in custody status including release, transfer, escape, or death.
- VINE is free, confidential, and available in English, Spanish, Somali, and Hmong.

# Inmate Information and Release Notification

## IF THE PERSON IS IN A DOC FACILITY

### **Request notification**

Victims and members of the public can request custody status notifications of incarcerated persons in a Minnesota Department of Corrections facility through Haven, including:

- Custody status changes including transfers, custody reduction, and interstate transfer requests
- Release notifications
- Early release programs
- Supervision status changes
- Change in case worker or supervising agent
- Offender escape and apprehension

### **Other assistance through Haven**

Haven provides information and the opportunity to request assistance with safety and security planning; reporting continued abusive behaviors or protective order violations by offenders; communicating with corrections staff throughout the person's incarceration and community supervision period; inquiring about restitution, and finding information related to all stages of the correctional process.
