An applicant for a motorcycle road guard shall not have:

- more than two petty misdemeanor convictions for any moving violation under Minnesota Statutes, chapter 169, or an equivalent violation from another state, for 24 months preceding the date of application;
- any qualified prior impaired driving incident, or an equivalent violation from another state, for five years preceding the date of application;
- any conviction under Minnesota Statutes, section 169.13, or an equivalent violation from another state, for five years preceding the date of application; and
- any conviction under Minnesota Statutes, section 609.21, or an equivalent violation from another state.

The personal information may also be disclosed pursuant to a court order or if requested by the state or legislative auditor.</p>
