ARSON INVESTIGATION

Subd. 3. Reporting and Records Requirements

The officer making investigation of fires occurring in cities, statutory cities, and towns shall forthwith notify the state fire marshal and shall, within one week of the occurrence of the fire, furnish to the state fire marshal a written statement of all the facts relating to the cause and origin of the fire, and such further information as may be called for by the blanks furnished by the state fire marshal.

- ✓ Training officers who can teach other department staff how to complete fire incident reports.
- ✓ Fire officers and chiefs who want to learn more about how NERIS impacts their department.
